# How to Navigate Virtual MMM 2020

## ***HOW DO I ACCESS THE VIRTUAL CONFERENCE?***

All registered attendees for MMM 2020 will receive an email on Monday, October 26 from our virtual platform provider, Underline. This email will contain your “Event Ticket”. You will simply click on the link provided, create your own account and password, and you will instantly have access to the virtual Conference website.

Once you are registered for the Conference and have created your account, you can access the virtual Conference website anytime by going to: <https://www.underline.io/events/34/reception>.

Please note that any attendees who register on or after October 26 will receive their Event Ticket within 30 minutes of completing their registration form.

## ***ARE THERE ANY BROWSER REQUIREMENTS?***

**Yes!** Make sure you are using a Chrome or Firefox browser and NOT Safari or Microsoft Edge. There is nothing else you need to download!

## ***WHAT TIME ZONE IS THE CONFERENCE IN?***

If you view the **Conference Program Overview [HERE](#)**, you will see all of the times are in Eastern Time (ET). In the Conference platform, however, the times on the “Schedule” right now are shown in Universal Time Coordinated (UTC). We are working on this programming now and very soon you will see that the times in the “Schedule” will adjust automatically to reflect your own time zone.

From the **Conference Program Overview** [HERE](#), you'll also notice we have spread our live sessions out across a 24-hour window. This is so that we can offer "golden hour" access to attendees across all major time zones.

### ***HOW DO I VIEW THE PRESENTATIONS?***

All oral and poster presentations have been prerecorded and will be available on-demand starting Monday, October 26, one week ahead of the Conference. These presentations are available early to give registered attendees the opportunity to view the presentations they are interested in and to submit questions to speakers via the Q&A chat box. Oral presentations will be located under the "Sessions" icon and poster presentations under the "Posters" icon.

### ***IS THE ENTIRE CONFERENCE AVAILABLE ON-DEMAND?***

**No.** The Monday Tutorial, all Symposia, and all Special Sessions (including the Workforce Forum, Writing Workshop, Magnetism and the Brain, the Young Professionals Event, and the Summer School Tutorials) will be shown LIVE during the week of the Conference and so these sessions **will not** be available on-demand the week of October 26. Click on the "Schedule" tab to see when these sessions will be shown live and then after that date the recordings will be available on-demand.

### ***HOW CAN I ASK THE SPEAKERS A QUESTION?***

Starting Monday, October 26, you can use the Q&A chat box in each presentation to send the speakers questions. Then, during the week of the Conference, November 2-6, each oral and poster session will have a dedicated 30-minute LIVE Q&A session (you can find these listed Q&A sessions on the "Schedule" tab). When you click on a session, you will see the first tile is a "Discussion Room". This Discussion Room is where the LIVE Q&A session will be held, and you can join it live during that session's assigned Q&A session day and time.

During the LIVE Q&A session, the Session Chairs may ask questions that have been posted on the individual speaker's presentation Q&A chat box, and you can also submit questions during these live events as well. Speakers will be actively monitoring their Chat boxes throughout the entire week of the Conference.

If you would like to continue a conversation with an attendee or a speaker after a LIVE Q&A session has ended, we encourage you to meet in our Open Lounge (located by clicking on the "Lounge" icon).

### ***CAN I SEARCH FOR A SPECIFIC PRESENTATION?***

Yes! When you click on either the "Sessions" tab or the "Posters" tab, you will see a white search box on the top right side of the page that says "Search Lectures". You can type in a keyword, title, ID number or presenting author name to search.

### ***ARE THERE ANY NETWORKING EVENTS?***

**Yes!** We are using an interactive platform called Gather.Town for all of our networking events. You can access all these events by clicking on the "Lounge" icon.
